CGRA 151 — Overview of Tutorials and Assignments 2019

There are five assignments: three programming assignments, a mathematics worksheet, and a programming project. The deadline for each, is Tuesday 9am of their respective hand-in weeks. The three programming assignments are due in Weeks 2, 4 and 9. The mathematics worksheet is due in Week 6. The project has two hand-in dates: a plan in Week 7 and the program itself in Week 12.

Each student attends a single one-hour tutorial session each week. You go to the same tutorial session every week. Sign-ups for tutorials are through myAllocator. Tutorials are in two streams. Stream A meets in CO242 and Stream B meets in CO243. The reason for the two streams is to allow us to do marking of each assignment over two weeks; it is the best way to schedule our markers sufficient time to see each student individually.

Each tutorial session will be one of the following:

Worksheet 50 minutes working through a worksheet and doing preliminary work on

the related assignment with a tutor to guide and help you.

Marking a 10 minute session with a marker, going over your work, and giving you

oral feedback.

Planning a 10 minute session with a tutor, to discuss your plan for your project. **Helpdesk** a tutor will be available to provide help with any problems you are having

with your project.
